

## CURRENT VOCABULARY (WORDS + SIGNS)

What signs and/or words does your child currently use?

It's best to make this list over a period of at least several days rather than guessing.

**Note:** A "word" is a sound or sounds that your child consistently uses to mean someone or something. The word may or may not sound exactly like the adult version of the word (it might be missing sounds or have substituted sounds). A "sign" is a movement that is consistently used to mean someone or something and also may or may not look exactly like the adult version of the sign.

(Check if your child verbally repeats this word)	Uses Independently? (Check if your child verbally says this word without anyone first saying it)
